QUALIFICATIONS

Applicants should have a Bachelor of Divinity degree or its equivalent. For admission to the Post-Graduate Diploma in Islam (PGDI), candidates must attend the Summer Course on Islam and Interfaith Relations (9-22 May 2011, for details visit: [http:// hmiindia.com](http://hmiindia.com)) and pass the PGDI entrance exam. Those candidates who are unable to attend the Summer Course will be given the appropriate reading material to prepare for the entrance exam.

METHODS OF ACADEMIC RESEARCH – first semester (optional):

Basic research skills needed for writing term papers, theses and book reviews. Students will evaluate sample academic articles and learn standard footnote and bibliography formats.

CONFLICT RESOLUTION WORKSHOP (compulsory for PGD degree):

The students participate in a two-week intensive workshop on Conflict Transformation offered by HMI's Praxis Department.

LANGUAGES THAT ARE OFFERED IN THE PGDI COURSE

Elementary Arabic, Persian or Urdu

ADDITIONAL LANGUAGE COURSES:

Non-intensive – HMI offers 12-week non-intensive courses in Arabic, Persian and Urdu each year for outside students, typically local Hyderabad residents. Instruction in each language is offered at four levels: basic, elementary, intermediate and advanced, and each level is offered each term.

Intensive Language Course — mid June to August 2011— An intensive 10-week language programme in Arabic, Persian and Urdu for outside students, typically from overseas.

Schedule: The summer intensive course is held from June to August, but the course can be held at other times of the year if there is student interest.
